

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The winning artwork in Section 1 will be acquired for the Warwick Shire Council collection.
2. Entry/handling fee for all Sections is \$27.50 (includes GST) per entry. Entries for Section 4 will be automatic for residents of the Shire of Warwick from entries in other sections. Entry/handling fees are non-refundable. Entry forms will not be accepted without payment for each entry. Cheques are to be made payable to Warwick Art Gallery.
3. Entries must not have been previously entered in the Warwick Art Prize.
4. Entries must have been completed in the last two years.
5. Whether or not a work is suitable for consideration in a particular section will be at the discretion of the judge.
6. An artist can enter a maximum of 3 entries across all sections
7. Entry/handling fee together with the completed Entry Form must be received at the Gallery by Friday 10 August at 4.00pm.
8. Wet canvases/frames are not acceptable
9. No artwork will be awarded more than one prize
10. Return freight arrangements must be clearly described on the entry form for any return of works. The Gallery will not enter into freighting arrangements for any reason. Enclose (in a separate envelope with your art work) freight and return address labels.
11. Minimum entry age is 18 years.
12. The judge and gallery's decisions about exhibition selections and the awards shall be final and binding, and no correspondence regarding these decisions will be entered into.
13. Entries in Section 2 must be accompanied by an image and dimensions for pre-selection purposes. Please do not send actual 3D work until you are notified after pre-selection. Digital photographs on CD are preferred. All entrants will be notified of the pre-selection result on Tuesday 14 August so that selected works can be forwarded.

Note there is no pre-selection for entries in Section 1 and Section 3
14. All paintings must be suitably framed and wired, ready for safe hanging. Stretched canvases are considered framed. D hooks must be used.
15. All works must remain with the exhibition for its duration.
16. All works must be available for sale. All sale prices must include GST (where artist is GST registered) and 20% commission applies. The Warwick Art Gallery shall retain this commission on all works sold. Payment of sales and acquisitions will be made within 30 days of the close of the exhibition.
17. Artists must allow their work to be reproduced by any form of the media related to the promoting of the event.
18. Exhibiting artists will receive a catalogue and an invitation to the opening on Friday 31 August.
19. The Warwick Art Gallery accepts no liability for loss or damage either in the course of transit or while such entries is in the custody of the Gallery. However, all due care will be taken of entries submitted. Insurance remains the responsibility of the exhibitor. Appropriate security will be in place during the Gallery's possession of art works. Paintings and pieces may be collected during gallery hours after the exhibition closes on September 30. Work not collected within 30 days of the exhibition closing will become the property of Warwick art gallery Inc.
20. All works should be delivered to the Gallery at 49 Albion Street, Warwick, Queensland by Tuesday August 21 at 4 pm. All work must be delivered free of charges during gallery hours. The Gallery will make no payment for freight or other charges incurred in delivery or return of work. All work must be correctly and safely packed for freight, and the packaging should be of a quality to allow for its re-use and safe return of unsold artwork.
